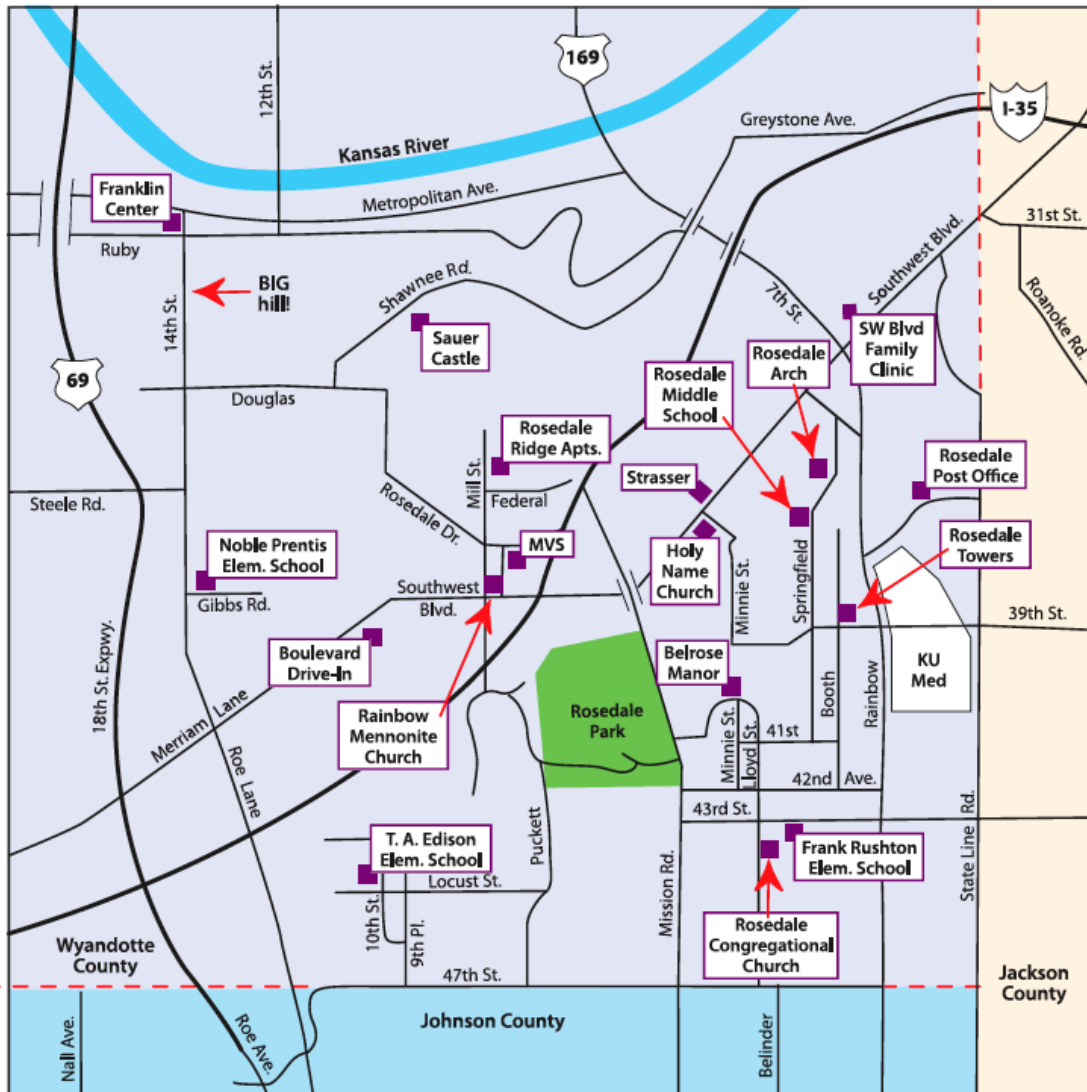


Rosedale Development Association

- **Our Community:** Rosedale is a four square mile community in southeast Wyandotte County, Kansas City, Kansas. Its borders are the Kansas River to the north, County Line Road/47th St. to the south, State Line Road to the East, and 18th St. Expressway to the West.

- **What We Do:** RDA is involved in every aspect of community building in Rosedale. From working with neighborhood groups to creating a more walkable community, RDA does whatever it can to make Rosedale a better place to live, work and play.
- **Our History:** RDA began as the Rosedale Community Council in 1945 as an organization to help the community address crime, zoning, flooding, abandoned buildings, area clean up. RDA became incorporated as a nonprofit organization in 1978.

- **Our Accomplishments:**
 - Act as an Enroll Wyandotte healthcare enrollment site
 - Built 3.5 miles of nature trails, mostly with volunteer labor
 - Successfully advocate for sidewalks, crosswalks, park improvements and bike lanes throughout Rosedale, including:
 - Mission Road sidewalk between 43rd Ave. and 40th Terr.
 - Bike lanes along Southwest Boulevard
 - Coordinate Walking School Buses, Reading Inspirational Stories to Empower reading event, Girls and Moms on the Move, Garden Club, and special events in partnership with Rosedale schools
 - Advocate for community improvement issues, like the Rosedale 105 bus line
 - Engage around 400 volunteers each year
