

#### **Overview**

The mission of Rosedale Development Association (RDA) is to work in partnership with residents, businesses, and institutions to build a strong and healthy community and to improve the quality of life for those who live, work, and play in Rosedale. On Saturday, May 6, 2017 RDA hosted our first disc golf fundraiser, the **Rosedale Disc de Triomphe**, a family-friendly tournament to support our work in the Rosedale community. Proceeds from the event will:

- Support RDA's Summer Youth Employment Program
- Provide minor home repair funding for Rosedale residents
- Support after-school programming and youth sports leagues
- Help RDA promote business development and a strong Rosedale economy
- Sustain RDA's presence as a community resource center

#### Goals

- 1. Raise funding to support and sustain RDA's work in Rosedale
- 2. Engage Rosedale / local businesses in the tournament
  - a. Use this opportunity to discuss with local businesses the services RDA provides
  - b. Promote the businesses and partners already working with and supporting RDA
- 3. Improve neighborhood engagement and perception of park safety through community events and activities in parks (Health Strategy B, Goal 2 in RDA's 2017 adopted goals)
- 4. Highlight one of Rosedale's gems, the Rosedale Park Disc Golf Course, and bring others from the Kansas City region into the work we do in Rosedale.

#### **Highlights**

Nearly 100 individuals joined us in the park, including players, spectators, and volunteers. 34 teams competed for nearly \$3,000 in prizes.
