It is with mixed emotions that I share with you that I have resigned from Rosedale Development Association to accept the position of Executive Director at the Kansas Center for Economic Growth, a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization that conducts research and analysis to promote balanced state policies that help ensure all Kansans prosper. My last day at RDA will be August 26, and my new position will begin in September.

The last seven years at RDA have been a time of growth, challenge, and progress. RDA seeking dedicated individuals to serve the community

This September, passionate and committed individuals will have the opportunity to begin a year of service in Rosedale. RDA is placing a team of six AmeriCorps members who will beautify the neighborhood, create green spaces, care for gardens and trails, repair homes for senior and low-income Rosedaliens, lead youth programs, and build community through neighborhood events.

We are seeking members who are passionate about the Rosedale community and committed to service. Candidates who are bilingual, candidates with home repair, gardening, bike repair or trail-building skills, and candidates who are experienced in working with youth will receive

special consideration. All candidates must be U.S. Citizens or Permanent Resident Aliens, over the age of 18, and have some college or verifiable work history.

Full-time service members will receive a bi-weekly living allowance of \$500, a Segal Education Award of \$5,775, and health insurance benefits. Half-time members will receive a bi-weekly living allowance of \$250 and a Segal Educa-

tion Award of \$2,887.50. All members will gain valuable work experience and leave Rosedale better and more beautiful. Service begins on September 26, 2016 and ends on September 25, 2017.
