

Important COVID-19 Updates from RDA

Dear neighbors,

Since the newsletter was printed, RDA has made some important changes in order to protect the health and safety of all those who live, work and play in Rosedale and our surrounding communities:

- 🏠 Rosedale Leadership Council is cancelled for March and April.
- 🏠 Volunteer workdays, including the Rozarks workday scheduled for April 11, are canceled.
- 🏠 Enrollment Nights for Rainbow Summer Program are canceled. Enrollment for Rainbow Summer Program will now take place online. Visit Rosedale.org, email info@rosedale.org, or call 913-677-5097 for more information.
- 🏠 The All-Rosedale Cleanup, scheduled for April 18, will be postponed and rescheduled once it is safe to do so.
- 🏠 The Rosedale Disc de Triomphe disc golf tournament, scheduled for May 2, will be postponed and rescheduled once it is safe to do so.
- 🏠 The Koch community center at 1401 Southwest Boulevard will not be available for rental for the next eight weeks, until May 12. Currently-scheduled rentals will be canceled and deposits returned.
- 🏠 Garden plot applications and Summer Youth Employment Applications will be moving online. Visit Rosedale.org, email info@rosedale.org, or call 913-677-5097 for more information.
- 🏠 As of Thursday, March 19, the RDA front office will be closed. Staff will still be responding to email and phone calls during normal business hours. If you call RDA, please leave a message, your call will be returned.

We encourage you to check on your neighbors by phone (especially elderly, those who live alone, those with disabilities, and those who have underlying health conditions), set up porch drop-offs for food and supplies to those who may be sick or self-isolated, consider ways to support local businesses and restaurants, such as buying food now to freeze or purchasing gift cards and using them for food delivery.

Finally, RDA will be connecting neighbors who are willing to help each other during this time.
